Item 1

Criminal Law and Family Law: Changes to Form MIL-100

The committee will review and discuss proposed recommendations following public comment in the report to the Judicial Council to revise form MIL-100. The report was drafted in collaboration with Criminal Law Advisory Committee staff, as the revisions to the form implement Family Code section 211.5 when a veteran files the form in a family law case, and also clarifies procedures under Penal Code section 858 when an active duty servicemember or veteran files the form in a criminal law case.

Item 2

Family Law: Child Custody Forms and Standard of Judicial Administration Under Senate Bill 599

The committee will review and discuss proposed recommendations in the report to the Judicial Council to implement Senate Bill 599 by amending Cal. Stds. Jud. Admin., std. 5.20; approving form FL-311-INFO; and revising forms FL-311, FL-341, and FL-355.

Item 3

Racial Justice Act proposal revision

The committee will review and discuss proposed revisions to the invitation to comment for a proposal implementing the Racial Justice Act (Assembly Bill 2542; Kalra; Stats. 2020, ch. 317) by adding four new forms effective January 1, 2025: Request for Relief Under the Racial Justice Act—Juvenile Adjudication (form JV-720); The Racial Justice Act in Juvenile Court (form JV-720-INFO); Findings and Orders On Prima Facie Case Under the Racial Justice Act—Juvenile Adjudication (form JV-722); and Findings and Orders After Hearing On Request for Relief Under the Racial Justice Act—Juvenile

Adjudication (form JV-722). The revisions include renaming the forms, separating the findings and orders form into two separate forms, and adding additional information to the forms, including more detailed instructions on how to complete them.
